A Constantly Evolving Cleaning Process

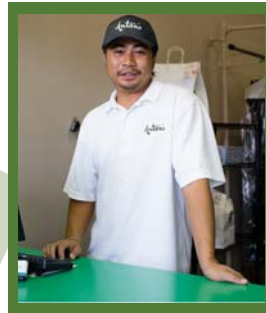
Our equipment replacement plan is based on an ongoing process of analyzing and researching environmentally friendly alternative drycleaning fluids. This continuing program has included the installation of multiple Green Earth™ and/or EcoSolv® fluid drycleaning machines and the elimination of “perc” machines.

Anton's wetcleans garments – Today, we wetclean more than 50% of all garments.

The traditional process is “dry” cleaning – which is not “dry” at all. Anton's, uses the industry's premier cleaning process to provide the highest level of cleaning quality. Sanitone® products are made using natural renewable resources.



At Anton's, we follow clothing manufacturer recommendations in selecting the best cleaning process. Our drycleaning and wetcleaning equipment is computer controlled for maximum efficiency and has helped reduce drycleaning fluid consumption by 90% over the last 20 years, as well as water consumption by 50%.



Environmentally Responsible Cleaning Personnel

Environmentally safe drycleaning requires extensive knowledge and proper training. Anton's Cleaners is committed to both. Our people receive continuous training to meet the company's rigorous cleaning performance standards.

Cleaning Industry Leadership

During the past three decades, Anton's has been recognized by government agencies (*US EPA, Massachusetts DEP, Massachusetts Toxic Use Reduction Institute*), the drycleaning industry (*Drycleaning & Laundry Institute, North East Fabricare Institute*), and by outside groups (*University Leaders for a Sustainable Future, Massachusetts Business Environmental Network*) as a leader in drycleaning industry environmental issues.

A Continuous Recycling Program

Long before recycling became an environmental necessity, Anton's Cleaners launched its recycling program. Today we're still leading the way in the drycleaning industry.

Recycling Of Drycleaning Fluid Waste

In 1982, Anton's was the first cleaner in the U.S. to recycle drycleaning fluids waste.

Using a sophisticated distillation process, we recycle drycleaning fluids. Other cleaners may “filter” drycleaning fluids or use the same fluids repeatedly. We are one of the only cleaners to use 100% clean fluids for every load of clothes, leaving your clothes odor free.



Wire Hangers

We make it easy to return wire hangers. You can drop them off at the Recycling Center in your nearest Anton's store. Also, be sure to pick-up a free hanger caddy, which will keep your used wire hangers neat, organized, and be just what you need to take them back to the store.

Plastic

Along with wire hangers, we also recycle the plastic used to cover your clothing. We urge you to collect it and take it to the Eco-Clean Recycling Center at your Anton's store. The plastic goes to a recycling company, not a landfill.
